District Cook Responsibilities:

- 1. Pass Illinois State Food Manager Test
- 2. Stocks supplies and daily menu items prior to and during serving periods
- 3. Follows directions from Head Cook
- 4. Rotates job responsibilities as needed
- 5. Ensures proper portion control and adherence to dietary guidelines for various age groups and special dietary needs
- 6. Serves meals in an efficient and friendly manner, interacting positively with students and staff
- 7. Assists in setting up and breaking down serving lines
- 8. Maintains accurate production records, temperature logs and other required documentation
- 9. Works cooperatively with other food service and school staff to ensure smooth and efficient operations
- 10. Participates in professional development as required
- 11. Assists in the preparation and service of food in an efficient and friendly manner
- 12. Assumes responsibilities of Head Cook, in his/her absences
- 13. Reports to the assigned workstation in a timely manner and as assigned
- 14. Ensures that meals are ready at serving time
- 15. Assists in daily clean up of the kitchen and surrounding areas, including trays, table service, utensils, and equipment so they are ready for the next workday
- 16. Assists in the storage and disposal of unused food in a safe manner
- 17. Assists in checking in, storing, and shelving food shipments upon arrival

- 18. Prepares food for full menu meal, salad bar and condiment table according to menus, special dietary or nutritional requirements, and number of portions to be served
- 19. Retrieves/stores items from/in storeroom, cooler or freezer
- 20. Sweeps and mop floors
- 21. Stores food properly and safely marking date and item
- 22. Complies with all county health rules and regulations
- 23. Reports any necessary equipment repair and maintenance to Head Cook
- 24. Performs other duties as assigned by Head Cook, Principal or Superintendent
