

Dale Garner Memorial Agricultural Scholarship

This annual scholarship was established in 2020 to honor Dale Eugeré Garner, a lifetime farmer from the Keithsburg Area. Dale started his career on the Shissler Seed Company Farm as a teenager, and continued to work for Jenks Family Farms after Shissler's sold. Dale continued to live and make a life there running the Keithsburg farm and at Sandy Oaks campground for over forty seven years.

His commitment to the agriculture industry earned him the reputation of an honest, hardworking, farmer who wasn't afraid to get his hands dirty or train and mentor the next generation of farmers. The gap that his knowledge and expertise leaves in the farming community is great and Jenks Family Farms hopes that this scholarship will attempt to somewhat stand in the gap in his absence. The purpose of the scholarship is to aid a worthy individual in furthering his/her education in an agricultural or trade school field.

The amount of the scholarship is \$500 and will be paid directly to the recipient after proof of enrollment at an accredited college, university or trade school.

Any senior attending West Central High School, who has participated in the Ag program, who is pursuing an agricultural field of study at a community college or university is encouraged to apply for this scholarship. Students who are interested in pursuing a trade school avenue of education are also encouraged to apply.

The deadline for submission of this application is April 15th

Finalists may go through a selection process to be chosen for the scholarship which may include an interview or committee discussion for recommendations with school staff. Recipient allows use of their award photo to be used in Jenks Family Farms publications.
